If you are not of legal age, please read no further. You must be of legal age for us to do business with you.

The following explains what we are doing, what kind of people we are seeking and how we are willing to compensate you. It also includes shooting tips as **you are responsible for providing your own photographer**. We do not require you to meet us or any of our representatives at any time. We do this for your comfort and safety.

Step 1 - Read the following four pages and make sure you understand how this works. you have questions, send an email and I'll respond the same day. If you would prefer to talk on the phone, send me your number and a few times when I can reach you.

Step 2 - If you are comfortable with this, the next step is to prove you are you. I know this sounds strange but many people pretend to be what they are not. So we want you to send us one or two images of you (nothing nude) and include the word "cameltoe" (hand written) somewhere in the image.

Step 3 - Based on what you send, we will contact you with an offer to provide images. * At that time, you will need to sign a contract (see page 4) and include a photocopy of your ID to prove you were of legal age at the time of the shooting. Remember, nothing nude. (topless OK)

Step 4 - We pay you based on the agreed amount. You mail us a CD of the images.

We are currently seeking about six models for this project. We will not begin the project until we have recruited all six. There is opportunity for repeat work, however we can't promise anything until after we have completed this first project.

Cameltoe Models: WANTED

Want to make some money without having to leave your house?

What Is A Cameltoe

Cameltoe is a slang term that refers to the outline of a woman's vulva when seen through tight, form-fitting clothes. Usually, a cameltoe is visible from the front. Some web sites are dedicated to publishing photographs of celebrities' cameltoes.

Where do you find Cameltoe?

Cameltoes are more likely to be visible under the following circumstances:

- Exercise shorts, stretchpants and leggings—including Lycra or spandex
- Hotpants (light colored is better than dark)
- Poorly designed jeans
- Very tight-fitting jeans or shorts
- Underwear or swimwear sized too small
- Vigorous or repetitive exercise, including running, especially in tight clothing
- Wet clothing
- Shaven genitalia (but it still needs to be covered!)



Cameltoe can be found in many places. On the sidewalk, sitting on a park bench, at the beach. However all of these locations yield what is considered candid cameltoe. There's nothing wrong with candid 'toe, but it's the most difficult to get because it's like bird watching. Sometimes you can go for hours and not find any!

About us

We are a US company working with a group in Ann Arbor that runs an adult site dedicated to women with 'toe. It's an adult site shows every different type of cameltoe with links to many other related sites. **While this is an adult site, it is non-nude.** We do not display any full nudity images. We believe true cameltoe happens when some type of clothing is being worn.

Our Project

We are seeking adult models who want to make some money in front of a camera. **You do not need any experience as a model. You do not have to "look" like a model.** What is required: You are comfortable wearing a small bikini or being photographed in your underwear and you have a body type that makes your cameltoe visible. (Remember, it's recommend you shave or trim before your shoot)

We will pay you for your time to do the shoot -- and we'll pay our more if your images are used. If you do well on your first shoot, we'll want you to come back on do another. If it goes really well, we'll want more of you every week.

How to Begin - If you are a model and want to explore this, your first step is simple! Get a camera, any kind - even a camera phone. Snap one or two images of you in a bikini (or anything similar) and email them to lisa@nakedpie.com. Remember, do not send anything nude. (topless OK) We are doing this for two reasons: To see how you photograph but mostly to prove you are really you and for this, we ask that you include the word "cameltoe" somewhere in one of the images. e.g.,
Written on a sticky note is fine

Is This For You?

These are the types of women/people we are seeking

1. Dancers, Wives and Girlfriends (Models)

We assumed dancers were already comfortable wearing bikinis and the idea of making money while wearing them; it seemed a natural. The wives and girlfriends ... that was intended to let readers know this wasn't just for dancers, but anyone who liked the idea of making money wearing bikinis. But dancing is certainly not a requirement. Some of our best models have been school teachers and bar tenders.

2. People Who Know People (Non-models)

If you know dancers or women described above, or even if you're someone with a decent camera and have access to a beach, there's opportunity. People with a camera, with the right attitude, in the right place, at the right time, have huge potential to generate revenue.

If you are over 18, like wearing skimpy outfits or and have access to those who do or attend public events where bikinis are in abundance -- there is opportunity here for you.

People we don't want: Anyone who thinks it's easy to get-rich doing this. Nothing here is too good to be true. We're only interested in working with people who want to build relationships for long-term business value.

What's In It For You

People do this for two reasons: Fun or money. Usually the second makes the first better.

What we are offering you:

- We will pay for individual shoots (lots of images on a CD)
- We will pay you to recruit others for individual shoots
- We will provide internet consulting to help you with any other business you are promoting
- We will share revenue with you and teach you how that's done

We are most interested in women who want to build their own website to create long-term financial opportunities.

What You Will Need To Do

IMPORTANT: If you have not yet contacted us, read the **How To Begin** on the back page. (above the model release form)
The following is information we are providing to help you with your first shoot. All you need is a digital camera and a friend to snap the shutter for you.

The Camera - The images should come from a camera that can take pictures at a resolution of at least 4 megapixels. If you don't know what this means, check the manual on your camera and see what's available. If you see 3.2 megapixels, or anything close, that will do. Just so you know, the cameras inside of cell phones can't achieve the level of quality necessary.

The Person Behind the Camera - Most find a friend to do this. Obviously it helps if your friend has done this before as a photographer knows what makes for a good photo. However, using a digital camera and following the shooting tips given on the next page, you can usually achieve great success even with a person who only knows how to press the shutter button.

Shooting Tips

Lighting is Critical - The success of your shoot will be determined by lighting. Natural light is always the best, so doing a night shoot is not recommended. Position yourself near a window. Morning or late afternoon light is best because the sun, being lower in the sky, casts more light through the window. Always put the photographer's back to the window.

We recommend you do not use the flash on the camera. Natural light is much better. However, if in doubt, try a few with the flash and see how they compare.

Secondary lighting (Optional) - Even with a brilliant light supplied by Mother Nature, you may also want to include some secondary light. This is not a requirement, but it can be a very nice addition and it's a way to have some fun with the shoot. One way to add this light is with a lightboard. To make one is simple. Just take a 2' x 2' cardboard and cover it with tinfoil. A light board is used like a mirror. You position it to the side and slightly behind the of the model. The lightboard should not be visible to the camera.

The Set - For your intro shot, a set can be any room in your house as long as the surrounding area is clean. It must be 100% clutter free. e.g., Great shots can happen in the kitchen, but all countertops must be empty. Refrigerator doors must be without soccer schedules or family photos. Outside shots are always great because trees, park benches and swimming pools are usually perfect as is.

Let's say you don't have a place at home where this works. Here's what we can do to help. In many areas, there are places where you can go to rent a themed hot tub by the hour. (Themed means you can select the decorations. e.g., Bali, Borneo Rainforest, Fiji...) If you have access to one of these, take your friend there with your camera. Just keep include the receipt with your images and we'll reimburse you. Remember to pay attention to lighting as you will not have the same control you would at home. (In this case, using the flash may be required) (Also, some places may not allow this, so ask first!)

Taking the Shots - Important Tip: Take many shots and you (the model) should move while shooting. Reason for this is that it may take 10 or 20 snaps of the shutter to get something that's good. Everyone has a good side, a good look. Professional models are able to produce this side/look on demand. Most can't. Don't worry. Don't let that keep you from trying. The benefit of the digital camera is that you can take hundreds and never worry about development costs.

If the camera has an auto-fire feature, use it. This means that it takes pictures as long as hold the shutter down.

Tip: Move during the shoot. Reach, bend, hands on hips, play with hair, make faces, grab/tug at your clothing ... Try to have fun when you're doing this as the camera will see that energy and happy always looks good.

Being Anonymous - If you want to remain anonymous in the images, make sure you indicate this on the contract. By anonymous, we mean that you do not want to have your face used in any of the images. To avoid having to crop off your head, we recommend you wear a big floppy hat, dark sunglasses or a wig. Another way you can achieve this is to never expose your face to the camera during the shoot.

Sending Images to Us - Images should be JPGs, however most cameras shoot in this format by default. If you don't know what this means, it's best to call us to confirm you have a camera that's compatible. You have two options: Write them to a CD or send us the memory from your camera.

Email is not an option because of size of the files. Also, we need to have the signed release form returned to us, so you must mail that anyway. If you send us your camera memory, we will download the images and return it to you the same day. If you work with us more than once, we'll purchase extra memory for you so you never have to be without what you send us.

Compensation - We will pay you for every shoot. The amount is pre-determined after you have made contact with us. (So you should do that first!) In all cases, we pay something as compensation is given in exchange for your transfer of these images to us. In other words, when you send us images, we are purchasing them from you. You keep whatever garments we send you.

Model Release Form

I declare that the photographer who took the photos and I, the model, have an understanding where by I have the rights to give full permission to use the images I supplied, both printed images and electronic files. I also declare that the person in the photographs is indeed me.

I hereby waive any right that I/we may have to inspect and approve the finished product or copy that may be used in connection with an image that the Photographer has taken of me or the use to which it may be applied.

I further release The Company or others for whom he/she/they is/are acting, from any claims for remuneration associated with any form of damage, foreseen or unforeseen, associated with the proper commercial or artistic use of these images...unless it can be shown that said reproduction was maliciously caused, produced and published for the sole purpose of subjecting the Model to conspicuous ridicule, scandal, reproach, scorn and indignity.

I acknowledge that the photography session was conducted in a completely proper and professional manner, and this release was willingly signed. I affirm that I am more than 18 years of age release all pictures taken under the terms above. I have read this release and fully understand its contents.
